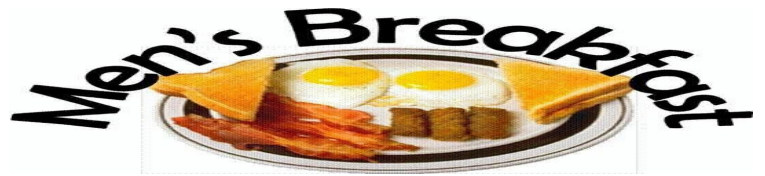
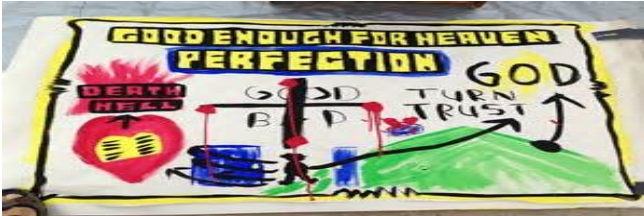

## CHURCH WEEKEND AWAY

21st-23rd September we will be holding our Church weekend away at King's Park, Conference Centre, Northampton. Booking forms have been sent out by email or hard copies are in the foyer.
