### THE NATIVITY PROJECT

The Nativity project will once again be taking place in December. The Brewery have given us permission to use the same building as last year from 4th-15th December. Once again this is a brilliant opportunity to share the real meaning of Christmas. Please make a note of the dates and why not consider taking time off work to get involved.

We estimate that the cost of this will be around £5,500 and if you would like to contribute to this please place this in an envelope marked "Nativity". We had a great time last year and we estimated that over 2,990 people passed through with around 1,439 of these being school children. Already up to date we have 1,722 school children booked in.
